FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN:

So then, with endurance, let's also run the race that is laid out in front of us, since we have such a great cloud of witnesses surrounding us. Let's throw off any extra baggage, get rid of the sin that trips us up, (Hebrews 12:1 CEB)

Well there is something to be said about having endurance. These past several months have been a journey that many of us would like to never travel again. In fact, these past few years seem like we are running a marathon - uphill, against the wind, carrying your over-weight friend, who is carrying a bowling ball - on your back. The amazing thing is that the finish line of this Godforsaken race is off in the distance, and every time we feel we are close to the finish, someone moves the line.

When we read the above passage, we can identify with the author who paints such a vivid picture of the race that has been laid out before each of us. The most interesting thing is that it is our individual races that must be run, so that we can reach the finish line before us. We are not racing against others, so why must we endure such a race? The answer can be found in the race itself. Our race is a marathon that tests our devotion to reaching the goal before us - an established relationship with Christ. We are drawn back to the text and we are readily reminded of the great cloud of witnesses. As Christians we are reminded of those who have completed the journey and now celebrate their eternal reward. But, let us focus on those in the shadows watching us. These folks are curious of the race and are wanting to be in the race as well. When we encourage them to set out on their own spiritual races, we are providing them opportunity for "hope" while they are already receiving, "grace and love".

So, to quote Sawyer Brown, "The race is on!" Let us finish this year with our heads held high. Folks, we are running but our faith is what is carrying us each day. Lace up those running / walking shoes, grab the word of God on the way out the door, and let's encourage others to get into the race.

Care News from Stephen Ministry

"Like one who takes away a garment on a cold day, or like vinegar poured on soda, is one who sings songs to a heavy heart." (Proverbs 25:20)

When people are suffering, do you struggle with knowing what to say? Do you wonder how you can relate to them in ways that will ease their pain and show how much you care? Do you pray you use words that won't add to their burden? Do you hope you don't seem too cheerful when you are with them? You want to be a good caregiver to those who are suffering, but it can be a challenge.

The founder of Stephen Ministry, Dr. Kenneth Hauck wrote the book, *Don't Sing Songs to a Heavy Heart: How to Relate to Those Who Are Suffering*, because he has had a heavy heart. Dr. Hauck's wife, Joan, died following a 41 month battle with ovarian cancer. For him compiling data and writing this book was personal. He assembled a research team that interviewed over 4,200 individuals who opened their hearts and shared their experiences. If you would like to know ways you can better support someone who is suffering, you can check out the book from the Stephen Ministry Library located in the choir room. Also, you may talk with our church's Stephen Ministers about ways to provide kind and thoughtful Christian caregiving.

Prayer from Dr. Hauck:

Dear God, I wish everything about relationships were easier. Sometimes I wish you could hurry up and finish perfecting me so I would always know what to do or say when someone needs comfort. No challenges, no problems,. But I know better. Thank you for being with me in real life, for helping me grow. Amen








Vacation Bible School
